

ORDINANCE NO. 186

SETTING REFERENDUM ON THE QUESTION OF A CHANGE IN THE FORM OF MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT

Whereas, S.C. Code § 5-5-20 authorizes Council by ordinance to call for an election on the question of a change in the form of municipal government;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Tega Cay in Council duly assembled as follows:

Section 1. A referendum shall be held on the 11th day of June, 2002, on the following question:

"Shall the municipality of Tega Cay change its form of government from the Mayor-Council form to the Council-Manager form?"


Those in favor of the question shall deposit a ballot with a check or cross mark in the square after the word 'YES', and those voting against the question shall deposit a ballot with a check or cross mark in the square after the word 'NO'.


Section 2. Public notice of the referendum shall be published in the Herald newspaper at least 3 weeks prior to the date of the referendum.


Section 3. If a majority of the votes cast are in favor of the change, the change shall take effect immediately upon ratification of voting results.


Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective on final reading.
