

State of South Carolina)	Ordinance Number 201 – AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 190, TO PROPERLY ACCOUNT FOR THE TEGA CAY BEACH AND SWIM CENTER OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Tega Cay owns and operates the Tega Cay Beach and Swim Center; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tega Cay has created the Tega Cay Beach and Swim Center Special Revenue Fund pursuant to Resolution 2003-06; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Tega Cay did, on September 16, 2002, pass a general operating budget for the City for the 2002 – 2003 fiscal year pursuant to Ordinance No.190; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tega Cay finds that, upon the advice of the City’s auditing firm, Sheheen, Hancock & Godwin, it is in the best interest of the City to reflect the revenues and expenditures of the Tega Cay Beach and Swim Center within the Tega Cay Beach and Swim Center Special Revenue Fund; and

WHEREAS, the fiscal year 2002 – 2003 budget adopted under Ordinance No. 190 incorporates the projected revenue and expenditures for the Tega Cay Beach and Swim Center.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED THAT Ordinance No. 190 be amended such that the revenues and expenditures for the Tega Cay Beach and Swim Center be transferred into the Tega Cay Beach and Swim Center Special Revenue Fund to facilitate the implementation of accounting practices recommended to the City of Tega Cay by Sheheen, Hancock & Godwin.


This ordinance will take effect immediately upon its final passage.


