County of York) An Ordinance Requiring Power
City of Tega Cay) Generation Equipment at TCUD Pump
Station Facilities

WHEREAS, The State of South Carolina mandates that all pump station facilities be equipped with power generation units sufficient to support the pumping equipment should electricity service to the station be interrupted; and

WHEREAS, because of its availability and consistency of service, a power generator unit fueled by natural gas is an industry preference for such needs; and

WHEREAS, as TCUD continues to grow more lift stations will be added to our wastewater system; and

WHEREAS, staff requests that Council adopt an Ordinance requiring the installation of natural gas powered generation units for our future lift stations.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED THAT the City of Tega Cay establishes Ordinance 229 requiring power generation equipment at TCUD pump station facilities; and


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED THAT when such stations are required to support new development within the City of Tega Cay, those entities implementing such development shall install the required natural gas power generation equipment at their expense.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.


