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Turf Grass Management for Tega Cay Parks & Athletic Facilities

The City of Tega Cay is seeking to contract with a turf management company to maintain the turf grass areas at several of its parks and athletic facilities. These areas include: Runde Park, Turner Field, Lookout Park, Windjammer Park, Koala Park, Diamond Head Park and Palmyra Park. Bid should reflect pricing for an annual maintenance agreement for services rendered. Bid submittals must include number of full time employees working for your company, equipment owned/ leased by your company, and total number of contracts your company is currently servicing. A list of references is also required. The City of Tega Cay is an equal opportunity employer. All bids will be opened publicly at 1 PM, on November 4th, at City Hall in Tega Cay. No bids will be accepted after 1 PM on November 4th.

Scope of work shall include:

1. Maintain all specified park and sports field surfaces including but not limited to fertilization, aerification, topdressing, chemical applications, and irrigation management. Work is not to conflict with field use schedules. It is the contractor's responsibility to "re-grass" worn areas on sports fields, to include seed or sod depending on location. Peripheral maintenance around the sports fields as needed to enhance/maintain aesthetics of fields is also required.
2. The Contactor is responsible for all mobilization and staffing levels so all work occurs in a timely manner.
3. Contractor must have a S.C. Commercial Pesticide Applicator license and provide proof of insurance and workers comp.
4. Applications of chemicals as needed to edge baselines, fences, control all weeds, control growth to reduce mowing frequency during the growing season, control grubs/insect /fire ant/ mole populations.
5. Irrigation management and repairs on all fields includes: maintenance/servicing of pump station, replacing/repairing items damaged by lightning, vandalism, mowing equipment, and wear, maintaining run times on a daily/ seasonal basis to ensure optimal field and growing conditions. Any repair or installation work to maintain the quality and integrity of the irrigation system regarding parts used shall be included in the total contract price.
6. Contractor is responsible for supplying all necessary fertilizer, chemicals, lime, and any other related materials and equipment required to maintain proper growing conditions.
