Annual Report for Public Works 2025

The Public Works department continues to be dedicated to serving the residents of Tega Cay by way of maintaining and enhancing the infrastructure of the City. We have been diligent in our commitment to provide a quality service to our citizens. The following list of statistics reflects the ongoing dedication of our department to the City.

- 1369 tons of yard debris were picked up, equating to 644 tons of mulch produced.
- 558 tons of leaves were picked up.
- 2,100 SF of asphalt roadway was patched.
- 27 potholes in the roadway were repaired.
- 2 guardrails have been repaired
- 195 LF of curb and gutter have been replaced.
- 186 panels of sidewalk were replaced.
- 389 sidewalk trip hazards were eliminated with our sidewalk mitigation program.
- 490 street trees have been pruned.
- 46 hazard trees were removed.
- 43 street/traffic signs were replaced.
- 100 deceased deer were removed.
- 22 stop lines have been repainted.
- 133 vehicles were repaired or serviced.
- 37 essential pieces of equipment were repaired.
- 35 electrical fixtures were replaced in City buildings.
- 20 City-owned buildings were inspected for safety compliance.
- On average, our weekly curbside collection was 186 brush piles, 64 bags, and 18 leaf loads.
- 462 strands of lights were installed for the holiday season.
- 70 median lights were repaired or installed.
- 23 street lights within the City were requested for repair by the energy provider.
- 80+ hours of safety training were completed by our department.
- 4,000 gallons of brine and 75 bags of ice melt were deployed during winter weather operations engaged by City.
- 12 street/roadway/infrastructure inspections and proof rolls were performed
